St Mary's Church - Accessibility

There are two entrances to St Mary's church, the North entrance, which has two steps up to the entrance, and another two steps down into the church. Handrails are in place on both sides and on all steps.





The South entrance is suitable for wheelchair users and is approached by the path from the war memorial.





The South entrance also has two steps with handrails to enter the church, however a portable ramp is available for wheelchair users. A toilet with disabled access is available in the church with access from the North aisle.





Inside the church, from the bottom of the portable ramp, there is level access through the central aisle of the nave and into the chancel.
